

VIETRADE - 3. Seaport

- Quy Nhon International Seaport is ranked to be one of the largest seaport in Vietnam. Its advantages are sheltered anchoring area, deep water level of 8.5m, wide warehouses, average tide of 1.56m, run stream of 80m in width (it shall be expanded up to 120m, dredged up to 11.5m). The seaport can accommodate the vessel of 30,000 tons. The cargo going through seaport reaches about 4.5 million tons/year. Quy Nhon seaport is 10km from national highway 1A, 175 sea miles from Da Nang port, 90 sea miles from Nha Trang port, 280 sea miles from Vung Tau port, and 455 sea miles from Hai Phong port. It is possible to reach to many large seaport in Asia

from Quy Nhon seaport.

- Thi Nai port is close to Quy Nhon port, with total length of mooring berth of 268m, deep water level of 4-6m, possible to accommodate the vessel of 3,000 - 5,000 tons. The cargo going through port is about 0.5 million tons/year.

- Nhon Hoi seaport of Nhon Hoi Economic Zone with the capacity of 12 million tons is being constructed.

4. Airway

Phu Cat airport of Binh Dinh province is 30 km from Quy Nhon city. Everyday, the flights of Vietnam Airline and Mekong Airlines to Ho Chi Minh city, Hanoi take off in here. The infrastructure serving for night flights in Phu Cat airport is being built.

Electricity supply

Various electric networks are available in Binh Dinh city: high-voltage, low-voltage lines and electric distribution stations. Electricity is supplied to all wards, communes in the province, particularly, 158 wards, communes are provided with national electricity network and 1 commune in Nhon Chay island uses diesel electricity.

Water supply

Capacity of water supply in Quy Nhon city: 45,000m³/day and night and the capacity shall be upgraded up to 48,000/ day and night.

Capacity of water supply to Phu Tai Industrial Zone: 8,500m³/day and night

Capacity of water supply to Nhon Hoi Economic Zone: 12,000m³/day and night (phase 1 is on progress).

Capacity of water supply to 9 towns in province: 21,300m³/day and night.

Furthermore, Binh Dinh province has repaired, improved and constructed 356 irrigation works of all kinds, including: 153 reservoirs, 107 spillways, 96 pumping stations.

Total capacity of water storage is 552.94 million m³.

Post-telecommunication

The post-telecommunication network with a variety of services can quickly meet the demands of communication. So far, total telephones of province are about 1.7 million (of which including 1.4 million cell phones and about 240 thousand fixed phones), reaching 115phones/100 people (up 25% compared with 2009).
